Eligibility: To be eligible for consideration, you must be 1) a secondary school graduate and 2) a current or past resident of Concord (MA) or Carlisle (MA), or have attended school in either of these towns.

How to Apply:

- 1) Complete the one-page Application Form with care. Sign and date it.
- 2) Mail your Application Form **postmarked by April 1, 2018**, to:

- 3) **Transcript:** Ask your college or post-secondary institution's Registrar to send an **updated and official** copy of your latest transcript to The Scholarship Fund of Concord and Carlisle at the above address, **postmarked by April 1, 2018**. Please notify your Registrar of your request well in advance of April 1st as it can take up to one month for transcripts to be processed by your school.

Note: Self-generated print-outs of your courses and grades are not an acceptable substitute for an official transcript.
- 4) **FAFSA:** Complete the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid** (FAFSA) and submit it to the federal government for processing. It may take up to four weeks for your FAFSA request to be processed. Plan accordingly. For information about the FAFSA, check online at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- 5) **SAR:** After fully completing and submitting the FAFSA, you will receive a report from the federal government called the **Student Aid Report** (SAR) with a calculation of the **Estimated Family Income (EFC)**. Please make a copy of your SAR and mail it to The Scholarship Fund of Concord and Carlisle at the address listed in instruction 2 above.
- 6) **Deadline:** In order for your application to be considered, we must receive your
 - Application
 - Official transcript
 - Copy of your SAR which includes the EFC calculation**All must be postmarked by April 1, 2018**
