



## 2019-2020 APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

**All scholarships issued by The Scholarship Fund of Concord and Carlisle are based on financial need. If you will be attending a college that meets 100% of unmet need as their financial aid policy, it is very unlikely that you will be eligible for an award from The Scholarship Fund of Concord and Carlisle.**

The information you provide in this application will be treated in strict confidence. The non-financial information on this application may be copied and distributed to the selection committees of the various affiliate organizations that provide scholarships through The Scholarship Fund of Concord and Carlisle. Please limit your responses to the space provided on this form. Do not enclose a résumé.

**Eligibility:** To be eligible for consideration, you must be a current or past resident of Concord (MA) or Carlisle (MA), or have attended school in either of these towns.

### How to Apply:

- 1) Complete the Application Form with care. It is the Awards Committee's first impression of you as a candidate for financial assistance.
- 2) Please do not submit your application until you are able to complete all of the information. That includes your college choice and financial details.
- 3) Sign, date, and mail the Application Form, **postmarked by May 1, 2019**, to

- 4) Mail your (1) official transcript and (2) copy of the **FAFSA**, **postmarked by May 1, 2019**.
- 5) **FAFSA:** Registration for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) is available online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). Complete the **FAFSA**. It may take up to four weeks for your **FAFSA** request to be processed. Plan accordingly.
- 6) **SAR:** After fully completing and submitting the **FAFSA**, you will receive a report from the federal government called the Student Aid Report (**SAR**) with a calculation of the Estimated Family Income (**EFC**). Please make a copy of your **SAR** and mail it to The Scholarship Fund of Concord and Carlisle at the address listed in instruction 4 above. Please do not send any other financial information to The Scholarship Fund of Concord and Carlisle - just the **SAR**.
- 7) **Transcript:** Ask your secondary school to send a copy of your latest official transcript to The Scholarship Fund of Concord and Carlisle at the above address, postmarked by **May 1, 2019**.
- 8) **Deadline:** Your application **must be postmarked by May 1, 2019**. Your secondary school official transcript, and a copy of your **SAR** which includes the **EFC** calculation **must be postmarked by May 1, 2019**, in order for your application to be considered.
- 9) **Interview:** Interviews will be scheduled for Tuesday, **May 14, 2019**. All awards are need-based. Students with demonstrated financial need who have completed their applications on deadline will receive e-mail notification of an exact interview time for **May 14th**. Interview schedules will be posted in Guidance offices and College Counseling offices.

*Applicants who miss their interview or send in a late or incomplete application will not be considered for a scholarship. Failure to check your e-mail for your interview time does not excuse you from your interview obligation.*
